THEME: Disrespect and Sexual Violence. Don't let it hide in the shadows.

In recognition of Sexual Violence Awareness Month (SVA Month), October 2022, the SpeakOUT Art Fair will provide a creative avenue for young people in the Cairns region to highlight themes and drivers of disrespect and sexual violence in our community. RespectMe is all about healthy, balanced, respectful relationships, and we have planned the SpeakOUT Art Fair to provide a flexible way for young people to express themselves and harness their unique strengths and creativity to help create a safer, stronger community for everyone.

Competition close extended to 4pm on Tuesday 4 October 2022

- 3rd Prize worth \$50

ENTRIES TO ART FAIR AND COMPETITION

Respect Me is calling for entries for the SpeakOUT Art Fair in the form of Visual Art - including painting, drawing, photo, textiles, mixed media, graphic art or digital art.

This art competition is for young people between the ages of 13 - 18 who live in the Cairns Region and surrounds.

Terms and Conditions

Artwork Themes brief

This art competition highlights the purpose of Sexual Violence Awareness Month (SVAM), to raise community awareness about sexual violence, promote the support options available to people affected by sexual assault and sexual abuse, and to uphold a clear message that sexual violence will not be tolerated in our communities.

This competition aims to provide a space for youth to express themselves through art and speak out creatively about issues that affect young people in the Cairns region. Young people are invited to submit a piece of artwork that aligns with one or more of the following themes.

Sexual Violence:

- Don't let it hide in the shadows
- Don't be shame
- Speak up for yourself and others.







The artwork should address these themes by illustrating one or more of the underlying drivers of Sexual Violence:

- Excusing violence against women Speak out about violence and disrespect in gaming, social media, or other pop culture
- Rigid gender stereotyping Speak out against attitudes that body shame, criticize, or try to push you into one limited gendered version of who you really are.
- Ideas of masculinity that emphasise aggression, dominance and control Speak out against attitudes that harm both men and women and force men to act aggressively and harmfully prove their manhood.

Entries open on Friday 24 June 2022 at 9.00am AEST. The competition will close at 4.00pm AEST on Tuesday 4 October 2022. Entries received outside of this time will not be considered.

Entrants must agree with the Terms and Conditions at the time of entry, and this will be acknowledged through submission of the Entry Form.

Entry is open to young people 13-18 years of age currently living in the Cairns Region and surrounds. Please note only one entry per person.

The entrant affirms that the submission (and any part thereof) is their own work and at the time of entering, they own the copyright to their artwork. Art may take the form of:

Visual Art - creativity expressed through the medium of visual art including:

- Painting, drawing
- Photo
- Mixed Media
- Graphics
- Digital Art (must provide an additional physical format for physical display)
- Textile/wearable art (must be able to be physically and digitally displayed)

Respect Me will appoint a panel of judges who will judge all competition entries. Entries will also be featured on social media in the lead up to the exhibition launch, and the popular choice will be given equal weight to one judge's vote.







There will be a First, Second and Third prize awarded, judged on a combination of art skill and interpretation of the themes of the competition. The judges' decision is final. No correspondences will be entered in to after this time.

Any artwork that is considered inappropriate due to offensive material as deemed by the organisation will be not included or accepted in competition.

The winners will be publicly announced at the opening night launch event during October.

1st Prize - worth \$200

2nd Prize - worth \$100

3rd Prize - worth \$50

Prize winners and entrants may have their artwork used and featured in the Respect Me program, on social media, or in promotional and educational materials to promote respectful relationships and consent. By providing your artwork to VPG in the SpeakOUT Art Fair, you agree to VPG utilizing your artwork for these purposes.

All entrants are responsible for collecting their artwork from Vocational Partnerships Group Inc after the exhibition by December 2022.

Exhibition

Respect Me intends to hold a virtual and physical exhibition of the artwork - the SpeakOUT Art Fair. Entries will be shared on social media as part of a targeted campaign to encourage young people to interact with the message and vote on their favourite art that represents a message.

Entries to the SpeakOUT Art Fair will be displayed in a local venue and online for the month of October 2022 during Sexual Violence Awareness Month. Launch of the fair will include an opening night event with local performing artists and will assist in raising awareness of the issues.
